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The Short Answer: What You Can Expect to Pay

A root canal in Melbourne typically costs between **\$900 and \$2,500**, depending on which tooth needs treatment and whether a general dentist or specialist endodontist performs the procedure. A front tooth with a single canal sits at the lower end of that range (\$900–\$1,400), while a molar with three or four canals — the most complex and time-consuming treatment — sits at the upper end (\$1,500–\$2,500). Specialist endodontists generally charge \$200–\$600 more than a general dentist, reflecting their additional years of postgraduate training and specialised equipment.

It is important to understand that the root canal itself is only part of the total investment. Most teeth that require root canal treatment also need a crown afterwards to protect the weakened tooth structure. A crown adds approximately \$1,200–\$2,000, meaning the total cost to save a tooth with root canal therapy and a crown in Melbourne in 2026 typically ranges from \$2,100 to \$4,500.

Despite the cost, root canal treatment is almost always more economical than extraction followed by an implant — which can cost \$5,000–\$7,000 — and preserves your natural tooth.

What Determines the Price of a Root Canal?

Root canal pricing is not one-size-fits-all. Several clinical and logistical factors drive the variation you see between quotes.

1. Which Tooth Needs Treatment

This is the single biggest factor. Front teeth (incisors and canines) typically have one canal, making them faster and simpler to treat. Premolars usually have two canals, and molars can have three, four, or occasionally five canals. Each additional canal increases the time, complexity, and cost of the procedure. A molar root canal can take 60–90 minutes compared to 30–45 minutes for a front tooth.

2. Specialist Endodontist vs General Dentist

General dentists can perform root canals, particularly on front teeth and premolars. However, complex cases — curved canals, calcified canals, molars, and retreatments — are best managed by a specialist endodontist. Endodontists complete an additional three years of postgraduate training focused exclusively on root canal treatment and use specialised equipment including operating microscopes and electronic apex locators. Their fees are higher, but their success rates on complex cases are

correspondingly superior.

3. Complexity of the Case

Beyond the tooth type, individual anatomy matters. Curved or calcified canals, teeth with previous failed root canal treatment (retreatment cases), teeth with perforations, and teeth with unusual anatomy all increase the difficulty and duration of treatment. Retreatment cases — where a previous root canal has failed and needs to be redone — typically cost \$1,500–\$3,000 because the clinician must remove old filling material, navigate altered canal anatomy, and manage any infection.

4. Technology Used

Modern endodontic treatment has been transformed by technology. Operating microscopes provide up to 25x magnification, allowing the clinician to see canal anatomy that would be invisible to the naked eye. Cone beam computed tomography (CBCT) provides three-dimensional imaging to map complex root anatomy before treatment begins. Rotary nickel-titanium instruments allow more efficient and predictable canal shaping. Electronic apex locators precisely determine canal length. Practices that invest in this technology generally achieve higher success rates, but these investments are reflected in their fees.

5. Anaesthesia and Sedation

Most root canals are performed under local anaesthetic, which is included in the treatment fee. However, patients with dental anxiety or those undergoing lengthy procedures may opt for nitrous oxide (happy gas) sedation or intravenous (IV) sedation. These additional sedation options add to the overall cost — typically \$200–\$400 for nitrous oxide and \$500–\$1,000 for IV sedation — but can make the experience significantly more comfortable.

6. Number of Appointments

Some root canals can be completed in a single visit, while others — particularly those involving active infection — may require two or three appointments with inter-appointment medicament dressings. Multi-visit treatment adds to the total cost through additional appointment fees.

7. Geographic Location and Practice Overheads

Melbourne CBD practices typically have higher overheads than suburban clinics, which can influence pricing. However, the difference is often less significant than the factors above. What matters more is the level of training, technology, and clinical rigour a practice brings to the procedure.

Root canal treatment is classified as a major dental procedure by most Australian health funds, meaning it is typically covered under extras policies with major dental inclusions.

What health funds typically cover

Most health funds cover a percentage of the scheduled fee for root canal treatment. The exact rebate depends on your level of cover, your fund, and whether you have served any applicable waiting periods (usually 12 months for major dental). Patients with comprehensive extras cover typically receive rebates that cover 40–60% of the cost of a root canal at a general dentist, though the percentage may be lower for specialist fees.
