Patient A: Full mouth rehabilitation

Concern: Patient A, in their early 60s, arrived with decades of accumulated dental problems: multiple missing teeth, failing crowns, gum disease, and significant bone loss. Several dentists had told them the situation was "too complex" to address, and they had largely given up on having a functional, attractive smile.

Treatment: A comprehensive, personalised treatment plan was developed with three specialists working in a carefully considered sequence:

1. **Periodontist** — treated the gum disease and performed soft tissue grafting to create a healthy, stable foundation before anything else proceeded
2. **Oral surgeon** ([Mr Kumar](<https://www.smilesolutions.com.au/our-team>)) — placed [dental implants](<https://www.smilesolutions.com.au/dental-implants>) in the areas of missing teeth, with bone grafting where needed to support long-term implant success
3. **Prosthodontist** — designed and fitted implant-supported crowns and bridges to restore the full dentition with natural-looking, functional results

Outcome: A fully functional, natural-looking smile — restored from what Patient A and multiple other practitioners had considered a hopeless situation. Because all three specialists conferred in person and reviewed the same imaging, the treatment plan was cohesive from day one rather than pieced together across separate conversations. Total treatment time:

approximately 12 months.

Patient B: Orthodontics before cosmetic dentistry

Concern: Patient B, in their mid-30s, wanted a [cosmetic smile makeover](<https://www.smilesolutions.com.au/cosmetic-dentistry>) but had significant crowding and bite issues that made placing veneers inadvisable without first correcting the underlying alignment. Skipping that step would have compromised both the appearance and the longevity of any cosmetic work.

Treatment: A sequential, two-phase approach built on forward planning:

- Specialist orthodontist** ([Dr Ch'ng](<https://www.smilesolutions.com.au/our-team>)) — [Invisalign treatment](<https://www.smilesolutions.com.au/orthodontics/invisalign>) over 14 months to correct alignment and move teeth to positions specifically designed to support the planned veneer outcome
- Cosmetic dentist** — once orthodontic treatment was complete, 6 [porcelain veneers](<https://www.smilesolutions.com.au/cosmetic-dentistry/porcelain-veneers>) were placed to refine the colour, shape, and symmetry of the smile
- Outcome:** A smile transformation built on a properly aligned, healthy foundation. Because the orthodontist and cosmetic dentist both work in the same building, the handover between phases was seamless — and the cosmetic dentist was involved in planning from the very first orthodontic consultation. That meant Patient B's teeth were moved to precisely the positions that would allow the best possible veneer outcome, not adjusted after the fact.

Patient C: Dental anxiety and complex treatment — sleep dentistry

Concern: Patient C had severe dental anxiety — a phobia that had kept them away from any dentist for over 15 years. By the time they finally sought help, they needed extensive treatment: extractions, implants, and multiple crowns. The idea of multiple conscious appointments was simply not workable, and without a way to manage that anxiety, treatment may never have happened at all.

Treatment: Smile Solutions offered [sleep dentistry](<https://www.smilesolutions.com.au/sleep-dentistry>) (intravenous sedation), allowing multiple procedures to be completed in a single visit while the patient remains completely comfortable and unaware. For Patient C, the oral surgeon performed extractions and placed implants whilst the restorative dentist prepared teeth for crowns — all in one extended session under sedation, with the clinical team working in coordinated sequence.

Outcome: Years of neglected dental treatment addressed in a single visit, with no anxiety experienced during the process. Follow-up appointments for crown fittings were also completed under sedation, keeping the entire treatment journey consistently stress-free. For patients whose anxiety has been the main barrier to care, sleep dentistry at Smile Solutions offers a practical, evidence-based way forward.

Patient D: Implants, gum treatment, and crowns — three specialists, one building

Concern: Patient D needed dental implants to replace two missing lower teeth, gum treatment around several existing teeth showing signs of periodontal disease, and new crowns on three teeth with failing old restorations. At a typical practice, this would mean referrals to an oral surgeon, a periodontist, and a prosthodontist — potentially at three different locations, with limited communication between them and no unified plan guiding the process.

Treatment: At Smile Solutions, all three specialists were involved from the initial planning stage, reviewing shared imaging and agreeing on the right sequence of care:

- Periodontist** — stabilised the gum disease with deep cleaning and localised treatment, ensuring a healthy environment before any surgical work proceeded
- Oral surgeon** ([Dr Bordbar](<https://www.smilesolutions.com.au/our-team>)) — placed two [dental implants](<https://www.smilesolutions.com.au/dental-implants>) once gum health was confirmed as stable
- Prosthodontist** — designed implant crowns and replacement crowns for the three compromised teeth, ensuring all restorations matched in function and appearance
- Outcome:** A coordinated treatment plan executed by three specialists who met in person, reviewed the same imaging, and agreed on the approach before treatment began. Patient D attended one building — Melbourne's Manchester Unity Building on Collins Street — for every single appointment. The functional and aesthetic result reflected what genuinely collaborative, comprehensive care under one roof can achieve.
