Sedation is administered by qualified specialist anaesthetists in a purpose-built facility. That's not standard across the industry, and it matters.

Your Sedation Options

Smile Solutions offers four sedation options. Your dentist will talk through which suits your situation and the treatment involved.

****Nitrous oxide (happy gas)**** is the lightest option. You stay fully conscious and aware throughout your appointment, feel calm and relaxed, and the effects clear quickly once the gas is removed. It works well for mild to moderate anxiety.

****Oral sedation**** involves taking prescribed medication before your appointment. There are no needles involved, which is worth knowing if that's part of what makes dentistry difficult for you. It produces moderate relaxation and many patients find it straightforward.

****IV sedation**** goes deeper. Administered intravenously, it keeps you conscious but in a state of deep relaxation. Most patients remember little to nothing of the procedure afterwards, which for many people is itself a relief.

****General anaesthesia**** is full sleep dentistry. You're completely asleep throughout, with a specialist anaesthetist managing your care the entire time. It's the right choice for extensive treatment or severe anxiety.

A Safety Distinction Worth Knowing

At many practices offering sleep dentistry in Australia, the dentist administering the sedation is the same person performing the dental work. At Smile Solutions, those two roles are completely separated.

Your specialist anaesthetist is there solely to monitor and manage your sedation. Your dental team focuses entirely on your treatment. Neither is splitting their attention. It's a more rigorous model, and it's the standard Smile Solutions has chosen to hold themselves to.

What Can Be Done Under Sedation

Virtually any procedure can be performed under sedation at Smile Solutions. That includes routine cleans and fillings, wisdom teeth removal, dental implant placement, oral surgery, and full mouth rehabilitation.

If anxiety has been the reason you've delayed treatment, whether for months or years, that's not an obstacle here. The specialist anaesthetist manages your sedation throughout, while your dental team handles the clinical work. The two operate in parallel, which is what makes complex or lengthy treatment genuinely manageable.
