Replace with: > "All-on-4 | 4 | \$20,000 AUD-\$40,000 AUD | \$40,000 AUD-\$80,000 AUD"

Note: The Smile Solutions source is clear — \$20,000–\$40,000 per arch. The current table's lower end (\$18,000) and upper end (\$37,500) are both inaccurate. Use \$20,000–\$40,000.
