Dr Angel offers comprehensive paediatric dental care for patients aged 0 to 18 years, including:

Preventative Dentistry - Oral health education for children and families - Dietary counselling and decay prevention strategies - Fissure sealants and fluoride treatments - Early orthodontic monitoring and referral

General Paediatric Dental Treatments - Check-ups, cleans and x-rays appropriate to age and development - Fillings and restorations using child-friendly techniques and materials - Paediatric tooth extractions

Philosophy of Care

Dr Angel believes that the dental experiences of early childhood set the tone for a lifetime of oral health. Her goal is for every child — regardless of their background, needs or anxiety level — to leave the dental chair feeling safe, respected and positive about their dental care.

By working closely with parents and carers, and by using clear, age-appropriate communication with her young patients, Dr Angel builds lasting relationships that support children's dental health from infancy through to adolescence.

Frequently Asked Questions

At what age should my child first see a dentist? The Australian Dental Association recommends a child's first dental visit within 6 months of the first tooth appearing, or by their first birthday. Early visits help establish a positive relationship with dental care and allow early identification of any issues.

What is a Specialist Paediatric Dentist? A Specialist Paediatric Dentist has completed a recognised postgraduate specialist qualification (typically 3 years full-time beyond their dental degree) specifically focused on the dental care of infants, children and adolescents, including those with special healthcare needs. They are registered by the Dental Board of Australia as board-registered specialists.

Does Dr Babu treat children who are very anxious about the dentist? Yes. Behaviour management is one of Dr Angel's special interests. She uses a range of age-appropriate, evidence-based techniques to help anxious children feel at ease, and offers nitrous oxide (laughing gas) and oral sedation where appropriate. General anaesthesia is also available for children who need it.

Can Dr Babu treat children with special needs or complex medical conditions? Absolutely. Dr Angel has specific experience managing medically compromised and special needs children, including treatment under general anaesthesia when required.
