Porcelain restorations generally last longer and maintain their appearance better over time, but involve a more complex fabrication process. Dr Henderson helps patients navigate this choice based on their individual clinical situation, aesthetic goals and budget.

How long do porcelain veneers last?

This is a question Dr Henderson has addressed in a published article. With proper care and maintenance, porcelain veneers can last many years — often 10 to 15 years or more. Longevity depends on factors including the patient's bite, oral hygiene, and whether they grind their teeth. Regular dental check-ups help identify any early signs of wear or issues with the veneers.
