Ryan subsequently spent six months as SHO in a ****consultant-lead endodontic referral clinic**** — gaining deep, specialist-level exposure to root canal treatment and the complex endodontic cases that require specialist assessment. This period laid the foundation for what would become one of his defining clinical interests.

Before joining Smile Solutions, Ryan spent a further three years as an associate in general practice, honing his skills in endodontics, aesthetic restorations and complex rehabilitation cases — and continuing to develop his expertise with nervous patients and sedation dentistry.

Root canal treatment is one of dentistry's most misunderstood and feared procedures — often unnecessarily. Dr Sherry's interest in endodontics, sharpened by six months in a consultant-lead endodontic referral clinic, means he brings specialist-level familiarity to root canal cases. He approaches these cases with the calm precision and technical skill that comes from extensive experience in complex endodontic scenarios.

Aesthetic Restorations
