Smile Solutions keeps things practical for students: appointments are available Monday to Friday from 8am to 6pm, with Saturday mornings also on offer, plus early morning, lunchtime and after-hours slots so you can fit a visit around lectures and tutorials without too much reshuffling.

Cost matters on a student budget, and there are a few ways to make treatment more manageable here. General check-ups start from around \$200 AUD, covering a clinical examination and professional clean with experienced clinicians. For students considering orthodontic treatment, Invisalign Express starts from \$4,400 AUD. Payment plans through Payright require no deposit, so you can spread costs over time rather than paying everything upfront. Free consultations are available for many treatments, which means you can get a clear picture of your options and costs before committing to anything.

If you're under 18, the Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS) may cover eligible dental services — worth checking if you're a younger student or have family members who need care.

With more than 80 clinicians on staff, Smile Solutions covers general dentistry, orthodontics, oral surgery, periodontics, endodontics, teeth whitening and wisdom teeth assessments. No referrals are needed to see a specialist — everything is available in one place, which saves a lot of running around the city.

The practice has been operating since 1993 and has seen more than 300,000+ patients. It holds a 4.9-star rating from over 937 Google reviews. The team is used to seeing patients who feel anxious about dental visits, and the setting inside the restored Manchester Unity Building is a lot more pleasant than your average clinic waiting room.

Dental health tends to slip down the priority list during university years, but catching problems early is genuinely cheaper and less time-consuming than dealing with them later. With Smile Solutions a short
