Their defining characteristic, and the source of both their clinical appeal and their irreversibility, is that they require the removal of a thin layer of natural enamel to create space for the ceramic shell.

The Three Ceramic Materials

Feldspathic porcelain is the traditional gold standard for aesthetics. Composed of more than 90% feldspar, its microstructure delivers unmatched translucency and opalescence, but relatively low flexural strength (approximately 70–90 MPa). Feldspathic veneers are hand-crafted by skilled ceramists using brush-applied layering techniques.

Leucite-reinforced glass ceramics offer a moderate improvement in strength (approximately 100 MPa) with a slight reduction in optical purity.

Lithium disilicate (IPS e.max) is the current clinical benchmark for strength (approximately 400 MPa) with excellent aesthetics. It's the material of choice at Smile Solutions for most veneer cases, offering a clinically proven balance of durability and natural-looking translucency that our experienced specialists rely on every day.

Adhesive Bonding: The Chemistry That Makes It Work

The longevity of your porcelain veneer depends as much on the adhesive protocol as on the ceramic itself. At Smile Solutions, the bonding sequence involves:

1. **Hydrofluoric acid etching** of the internal ceramic surface, creating microporosities
2. **Silane coupling agent** application, forming covalent bonds between ceramic and resin
3. **Dentine bonding agent** applied to the prepared tooth surface
4. **Dual-cure resin luting cement** — light-activated at the surface, chemically cured in deeper zones

This multi-step protocol creates bond strengths exceeding 20 MPa, comparable to natural enamel adhesion. When correctly executed, the veneer-tooth interface is actually stronger than the surrounding tooth structure.

- **Tooth reduction:** Crowns require 60–70% tooth reduction; veneers require 3–30% - **Indication:** Crowns are appropriate where structural integrity is compromised; veneers where the tooth is fundamentally sound - **Aesthetics:** Both can achieve excellent results; veneers preserve significantly more natural tooth structure

Daily Oral Hygiene

Your porcelain veneers require the same oral hygiene discipline as natural teeth, with a few specific considerations:

- **Brushing:** Use a soft-bristled toothbrush and non-abrasive toothpaste. Abrasive whitening toothpastes can dull the veneer surface over time.
- **Flossing:** Floss daily, using a gentle sliding motion at the veneer margin rather than a snapping motion.
- **Mouthwash:** Avoid alcohol-based mouthwashes, which can degrade the resin luting cement over time.

Dietary Considerations

- Avoid biting directly into very hard foods (crusty bread, hard lollies, ice) with your veneered teeth
- Minimise staining beverages (coffee, red wine, tea), or rinse with water immediately afterwards
- Porcelain itself is highly stain-resistant; the resin cement at the margins is more susceptible

Bruxism Management

If you have a history of bruxism or clenching, wearing a custom occlusal splint every night is non-negotiable for the long-term survival of your veneers. Smile Solutions provides custom-fabricated splints and monitors occlusal wear at your routine reviews.

Professional Maintenance

- Six-monthly professional cleans are recommended - Let your hygienist know you have porcelain veneers — ultrasonic scalers should be used with care at veneer margins - Annual photographs allow our team to monitor any changes in shade, margin integrity, or gum position

Expected Longevity

****Q:** Do porcelain veneers hurt? **** A:** The preparation appointment is conducted under local anaesthetic and is not painful. Some patients experience sensitivity during the temporary phase, which resolves after your final veneers are placed. Post-placement sensitivity is uncommon with lithium disilicate veneers, and our team will look after you throughout the process.

****Q:** Can I whiten my teeth after getting veneers? **** A:** Porcelain does not respond to whitening agents. If you're considering whitening, it should be completed before your veneers are placed so the veneer shade can be matched to your whitened natural teeth. At Smile Solutions, we recommend a whitening phase prior to veneer fabrication where appropriate — it's part of our treatment planning process.

****Q:** How many veneers do I need? **** A:** This depends on your smile line — how many teeth are visible when you smile. Most full smile makeovers involve 6–10 upper veneers. ****Q:** Can veneers fix crooked teeth? **** A:** Veneers can mask minor malalignment — small rotations, slight crowding, or diastemas.
