The resin is carefully sculpted, shaped and polished to improve the appearance of one or more teeth. When applied across the full front surface, it's known as a composite veneer.

This minimally invasive procedure has become increasingly popular amongst patients seeking cosmetic improvements without extensive tooth preparation. The composite resin material we use at Smile Solutions is specially formulated to mimic the natural translucency and colour of tooth enamel, ensuring seamless integration with your existing smile. ****Curing**** — A blue ultraviolet light is used to harden the resin, bonding it securely to your tooth structure. This process makes the material durable and long-lasting.

****Finishing**** — Your dentist trims any excess, refines the shape and polishes the tooth for a flawless, natural finish. The final polish creates a smooth surface that reflects light naturally, just like your own enamel.

The entire process can often be completed in a single visit, as composite veneers are crafted in-house without the need for a dental laboratory. Most patients can expect their appointment to last between 30 minutes to two hours, depending on the number of teeth being treated. ****Avoid staining foods and beverages**** — Coffee, tea, red wine and tobacco can discolour composite resin over time. If you do consume these, rinse your mouth with water afterwards.

****Protect against damage**** — Avoid biting hard objects like ice, pens or fingernails, and consider a nightguard if you grind your teeth. Our team can provide a custom-fitted nightguard for optimal protection.

****Schedule regular check-ups**** — Professional cleanings and examinations help maintain the integrity and appearance of your bonding. Our comprehensive dental care approach means we monitor your results over time.

****Address issues promptly**** — If you notice chipping, staining or rough edges, contact us for a simple repair or polish. Early intervention prevents minor issues from becoming more significant.
