Most dental practices across Australia run with a small team of general dentists, perhaps two or three clinicians, a hygienist, a handful of support staff, and a list of external specialists for cases that exceed their scope. This model works, but it has a built-in limitation: the moment you need a specialist, you leave. Different building, different team, different records system, and a coordination relationship managed through referral letters and phone calls between clinicians who may rarely meet.

Smile Solutions, in the Manchester Unity Building at 220 Collins Street in Melbourne's CBD, is genuinely different. It's Australia's largest single-location private dental practice, with over 80 clinicians working across multiple floors of a heritage art deco building, including more than 25 registered dental specialists. The Collins Street Specialist Centre, the specialist hub within Smile Solutions, brings together more specialty disciplines under one roof than any other private dental practice in Australia. If you're in Melbourne and you want world-class care, that matters.

****The full roster: experienced specialists across every discipline****

The specialist team at Smile Solutions covers the complete range of dental specialties recognised under Australian health practitioner regulation.

Endodontics, the specialty concerned with a tooth's internal structure, root canal treatment, and root surgeries, is covered by four specialist endodontists. Having four endodontists within a single practice means genuine availability, specialist-level peer review, and the capacity to manage complex multi-rooted cases, calcified canals, and retreatments that would challenge even experienced general clinicians.

Periodontics, focused on gums, supporting bone, and the soft tissues of the mouth, is covered by three specialist periodontists, plus Dr Simon Hinckfuss, who holds dual registration as both a Specialist Prosthodontist and a Specialist Periodontist. That's a particularly deep bench of periodontal expertise. Gum disease, bone loss, gum grafting, peri-implant disease, and soft tissue aesthetics all fall within the periodontists' domain.

Orthodontics is handled by three specialist orthodontists, each holding formal postgraduate orthodontic qualifications, not general dentists who've completed a short orthodontic course. If you have complex alignment needs, skeletal discrepancies, or adult orthodontic requirements involving multiple disciplines, that distinction matters for your outcome.

Oral and maxillofacial surgery, covering wisdom tooth removal, implant surgery, jaw surgery, facial trauma, and pathology, is provided by two specialist surgeons. Having oral surgeons in-house means the surgical care most practices refer out is available on-site, and those surgeons work in direct, day-to-day collaboration with the rest of the specialist team.

Prosthodontics, specialist tooth restoration through crowns, bridges, veneers, implant restorations, and full-mouth rehabilitation, is led by Dr Simon Hinckfuss. His dual specialist credentials make him well-placed to manage both the periodontal foundation and the restorative superstructure of complex cases.

Paediatric dentistry is led by Dr Susan Hinckfuss through the dedicated Tooth Fairy Centre, a children's dental hub within the practice with its own specialist focus and an environment designed with younger patients in mind.

This roster, four endodontists, three periodontists, one dual specialist, three orthodontists, two oral surgeons, one paediatric specialist, twelve or more general dentists, hygienists, oral health therapists, and master ceramist Greg Karabasis in the in-house Smile Lab, didn't come together by accident. It reflects a deliberate vision of what a practice built around multidisciplinary specialist care should look like.

****Why it matters: the case for co-location****

The argument for having all these specialists together isn't simply about convenience, though that convenience is real. The deeper argument is about the quality of care.

When specialists from different disciplines work under the same roof, share the same patient records, attend the same case review meetings, and collaborate on the same treatment plans, the clinical decisions they make are better. A periodontist who can walk to the orthodontist's surgery and say

"before we move these teeth, I want you to look at the bone support on the upper left" is having a fundamentally different conversation than one who sends a letter and waits for a reply. An endodontist who can consult the prosthodontist about a tooth's restorative prognosis before committing to root canal treatment, or advising extraction and implant, makes a more informed recommendation.

This is multidisciplinary care in its truest form. Not the bureaucratic coordination of separate specialists who happen to share a patient, but colleagues who know each other, trust each other, and think together about the people in their shared care. Nothing slips through the cracks because the full weight of the team's combined expertise is brought to bear on every complex case.

At Smile Solutions, formal case review and peer review are embedded in the practice culture. Complex cases are discussed. Treatment plans are reviewed with your needs at the centre. That simply cannot happen when specialists practise in isolation.

****The Manchester Unity Building: five floors and a tower****

The physical home of the Collins Street Specialist Centre is as distinctive as the practice itself. The Manchester Unity Building is one of Melbourne's most recognisable heritage landmarks, a Gothic Revival art deco building completed in 1932, with a tower visible across the CBD skyline. It was listed on the Victorian Heritage Register in 1992, the year before Smile Solutions first opened its doors at the same address.

The practice occupies five floors of the building plus the tower space, a footprint that reflects the scale of what has been built here over more than three decades. When Dr Kia Pajouhesh founded Smile Solutions in 1993, he established it at 220 Collins Street with a clear vision of what comprehensive dental care could be. Thirty-four years later, the practice has treated over 300,000 patients and grown into an institution, one that won the Telstra Victorian Business of the Year award in 2014, collected multiple Australian Business Awards, and built a reputation that extends well beyond Melbourne.

The location is as accessible as any address in the city. Collins Street sits at the heart of Melbourne's CBD, serviced by trams running along the street itself, walking distance from Flinders Street Station and Federation Square, and close to multiple car parking options.

****The Core Dental network and the integrated referral pathway****

Smile Solutions sits at the apex of the Core Dental Group, a network of dental practices operating across Melbourne's suburbs, including locations in Caroline Springs, Berwick, and Epping. These practices run on CareStack, a shared cloud-based practice management system, which means patient records, treatment histories, X-rays, and clinical notes are accessible across the network.

When you're a patient at a Core Dental location and you need specialist care, a complex implant, orthodontic treatment, root canal from a specialist, or a full-mouth rehabilitation, your referral pathway to Smile Solutions is straightforward. Your referring general dentist and the Smile Solutions specialist share a records platform, speak the same clinical language, and operate within the same practice group. You don't fall between the cracks.

This means the Collins Street Specialist Centre functions as a specialist hub for an entire network of Melbourne practices, not just for patients who present directly from the CBD, but for the broader patient community of the Core Dental Group. Wherever you start your care journey, the pathway to specialist treatment is clear.

****No other practice in Australia offers this****

There is no other single-location private dental practice in Australia that concentrates this many registered dental specialists under one roof. Teaching hospitals and university clinics have broad specialist coverage, but they're not private practices. Specialist referral centres exist, but they're typically single-specialty or dual-specialty environments. Large group practices have multiple locations,

but the specialists are distributed across different sites.
