What remains genuinely rare is a dental practice that can actually deliver comprehensive care across all of these domains. Not refer out. Not coordinate between separate practices. Not manage some of the layers and hope someone else manages the rest. Everything, in-house, with experienced specialists in every required discipline, shared records, shared imaging, and a treatment philosophy that sees your mouth as a connected system rather than a collection of individual teeth.

Smile Solutions, together with the Core Dental Group and the Collins Street Specialist Centre, is that practice. There is no equivalent in Australia.

The three layers — and why they require specialist depth

Oral health and longevity care operates across three interconnected layers, and understanding how they work together is the key to understanding why your overall wellbeing is so closely tied to what happens in your mouth.

****Layer 1 — Oxygen, breathing and sleep.**** Ensuring adequate oxygen intake and restorative sleep through proper airway function, neuromuscular balance, and the diagnosis and management of obstructive sleep apnoea, bruxism, and temporomandibular dysfunction.

****Layer 2 — The microbiology of the mouth.**** Rebalancing your oral microbiome to reduce the pathogenic bacterial load linked to Alzheimer's disease, cardiovascular disease, diabetes, and systemic inflammation.

****Layer 3 — Functional restoration, occlusion and lifelong nutrition.**** Creating and maintaining a dentition that is structurally sound, precisely aligned, functionally balanced, and capable of sustaining quality nutrition for life — protecting your ability to eat hard, nutritious food well into old age.

Each layer requires a different set of clinical skills and specialist-level expertise. And the layers are interdependent in ways that matter clinically: bruxism (Layer 1) may be driven by occlusal imbalance (Layer 3), which accelerates periodontal breakdown (Layer 2). Treating one layer while ignoring the others produces incomplete outcomes.

This is why most dental practices cannot deliver this care. Not because their dentists aren't capable, but because the clinical infrastructure simply doesn't exist. A single general dentist, or even a small group practice with one or two visiting specialists, doesn't have the breadth of specialist disciplines required to address all three layers at once.

Smile Solutions does.

Layer 1: Every specialist you need — in-house

Managing oxygen, breathing and sleep in a dental context requires genuine collaboration between sleep physicians, prosthodontists, orthodontists, oral and maxillofacial surgeons, osteopaths, and myofunctional therapists. At most practices, this means referrals to five or six separate providers, with you carrying your own records between appointments and hoping the clinicians communicate with each other.

At Smile Solutions, every one of these clinicians practises within the same clinical network — so your care is coordinated, connected, and centred on you.

****Sleep physician collaboration.**** The TMD and Sleep Clinic works directly with board-registered specialist medical sleep physicians. You're referred for formal polysomnography, and the results are shared and discussed within the treatment planning process — not sent as a letter weeks later.

****Specialist prosthodontists.**** Optimising your occlusion during function — establishing stable centric occlusion and its functional relationship with centric relation, balancing your bite, removing non-working side interferences, and creating anterior and canine guidance where it doesn't exist naturally — is performed by specialist prosthodontists who are physically in the building.

****Specialist orthodontists.**** Arch expansion to open your airway, alignment to improve tongue posture and nasal breathing, and coordination with oral surgeons for orthognathic correction when the

obstruction is skeletal — all delivered by board-registered specialist orthodontists on-site.

****Oral and maxillofacial surgeons.**** Corrective jaw surgery for patients whose sleep apnoea is rooted in skeletal jaw structure. These surgeons consult and operate from within the Smile Solutions Group.

****Osteopaths and myofunctional therapists.**** In-house practitioners who address the musculoskeletal component of TMD — muscle tension, fascial restriction, postural dysfunction, tongue posture retraining, and breathing habit correction — with a gentle and caring approach.

Managing the microbiology of your mouth requires the ability to identify pathogenic bacteria, treat the periodontal disease that harbours them, eliminate hidden infections, replace failing restorations that leak bacteria, and support your home care with clinician-selected products. At Smile Solutions, every step of this process is managed internally.

****Specialist periodontists.**** Board-registered specialist periodontists diagnose and treat periodontal disease — deep pocket management, surgical intervention, gum grafting for recession, and long-term maintenance programmes. They understand the oral-systemic connection because they see its consequences every day, and they coordinate with your cardiologist and physician when the clinical picture warrants it.

****Specialist endodontists.**** Failing root canals that harbour bacterial populations at the apex of the tooth — sometimes forming silent abscesses that drain bacteria into the body for years — are assessed and retreated by board-registered specialist endodontists. Not general dentists attempting specialist procedures. Dedicated specialists.

****AirFlow biofilm management.**** The hygiene department uses AirFlow Prophylaxis Master technology for biofilm removal, a system that reaches into pockets, around restorations, and into fissures more effectively and comfortably than traditional scaling.

****Microbiological analysis.**** Assessment of the bacterial flora of your mouth to identify pathogenic species and guide targeted, personalised treatment. This is not a generic clean — it's a data-driven approach to rebalancing your microbial ecosystem.

****CBCT imaging for hidden infections.**** Dental abscesses can sit silently beneath teeth for years. Collins Street Imaging provides comprehensive 3D imaging that reveals infections invisible on standard X-rays, without any external referral.

****In-house ceramic laboratory.**** When failing restorations need replacement — and they do, because every leaking margin is a bacterial reservoir — the Smile Lab fabricates ceramic restorations on-site using CEREC technology and TGA-approved materials. Your ceramist is in the building. Your dentist and ceramist consult in person. Your restoration is designed for minimal margins and maximum seal. No offshore laboratory. No two-week wait.

Layer 3: The full restorative and functional capability

Creating a mouth that is structurally sound, precisely aligned, functionally balanced, and capable of sustaining quality nutrition for life requires the most diverse clinical team of all three layers — prosthodontists, orthodontists, periodontists, oral surgeons, endodontists, general dentists, and ceramists, all working from a single treatment plan built around your needs.

At Smile Solutions, this is not aspirational. It is operational.

****Specialist prosthodontists**** design your occlusal scheme — the way your teeth come together in static occlusion and the way they guide against each other during function. They establish stable centric occlusion and its relationship with centric relation. They create anterior and canine guidance through restorative work when it doesn't exist naturally. They equilibrate your bite, remove non-working side interferences, and design restorations that protect your TMJ joints for decades. This is the most technically demanding work in dentistry, and it's performed by specialists who do nothing else.

****Specialist orthodontists**** align your teeth for three purposes: hygiene access (aligned teeth are cleanable teeth, directly supporting Layer 2), airway improvement (arch expansion opens the tongue space and improves breathing, directly supporting Layer 1), and functional occlusion (ideal tooth position enables ideal bite function, the core of Layer 3).

****Specialist periodontists and oral and maxillofacial surgeons**** place dental implants to replace missing teeth. Every missing tooth reduces chewing capacity, and every reduction in chewing capacity pushes your diet toward softer, less nutritious, higher-sugar foods. Implants restore the structural integrity of your arch and preserve your ability to eat well for life.

****Specialist endodontists**** ensure that every tooth worth saving is saved — with root canal treatments that eliminate infection and preserve your natural tooth structure for as long as possible.

****The Smile Lab**** fabricates every ceramic restoration — crowns, veneers, inlays, onlays, implant prosthetics — right here in Melbourne, in-house, using TGA-approved materials. The ceramists work exclusively for Smile Solutions. They consult with your treating dentist in person. They shade-match under the same lighting as your treatment room. Your restorations are designed for longevity: minimal margins, precise fit, surfaces that resist bacterial adhesion and withstand the forces of chewing for decades.

****Corrective jaw surgery**** for patients whose bite problems and airway obstruction are skeletal in origin is planned jointly by specialist orthodontists and oral and maxillofacial surgeons — both of whom practise within the group. The surgery corrects the bite and opens the airway in a single, coordinated treatment plan that addresses Layer 1 and Layer 3 at the same time.

Why this level of care cannot be replicated easily

The clinical infrastructure described above wasn't assembled overnight. Smile Solutions has been building this capability for over 33 years. The practice was founded in 1993 with a single dental chair and eight patients.
