And in most cases, that local dentist can do one of two things: attempt to manage it themselves, regardless of whether the problem actually falls within their skill set, or refer you to a specialist and send you on your way to wait days, weeks, or sometimes months for an appointment.

The first option carries real risk. A difficult surgical extraction attempted by a general dentist without oral surgery training, or a complex root canal started without the right equipment or expertise — that's where complications happen, and where your wellbeing is genuinely on the line.

The second option means leaving with a referral letter, a set of X-rays that may or may not transfer to the specialist's system, and the job of finding and booking yourself in with someone who has never seen you, has no access to your records, and may not be free for weeks. Meanwhile, you're in pain.

At Smile Solutions, neither of those scenarios applies.

One location, every specialist, immediate escalation

Smile Solutions operates from the heritage-listed Manchester Unity Building at 220 Collins Street in Melbourne's CBD — open Monday to Friday from 8am to 6pm and on Saturdays, directly opposite Town Hall station on the Metro Tunnel line, with trains running every three to four minutes.

When you present with a dental emergency, you're first seen by one of Smile Solutions' experienced general dentists, who assess your situation, take any necessary imaging, and work out exactly what your emergency requires. What happens next is what makes Smile Solutions genuinely different from any other dental practice in Melbourne.

If your emergency requires surgical extraction — an impacted wisdom tooth, a complex root fracture, a tooth that can't be removed with conventional forceps — you're referred immediately to one of Smile Solutions' two specialist oral and maxillofacial surgeons, A/Prof Patrishia Bordbar or Dr Ricky Kumar, who practise in the same building. Not next week. Not after you call their rooms and wait for

availability. That day.

****If your pain is coming from an infected or dying nerve**** and you need root canal treatment, you're referred immediately to one of Smile Solutions' four specialist endodontists — Dr Gregory Tilley, Prof Chankhrit Sathorn, Dr Aovana Timmerman, or Dr Areti Vrochari — all on-site and ready to help.

****If the pain is periodontal**** — a gum abscess, a deep pocket infection, acute periodontal breakdown — you're referred to the senior oral health therapists in the periodontal team and to one of the specialist periodontists within the practice, who can assess and begin treatment the same day.

****If the pain is jaw, joint, or muscle related**** — TMD, facial muscle pain, a locked jaw, or an acute flare-up of an existing jaw condition — you're referred immediately to the TMD clinic led by Dr Kia Pajouhesh, where experienced, personalised treatment begins without delay.

****If a tooth is badly broken and needs complex restoration**** — a fractured cusp, a shattered crown, a tooth that needs rebuilding under load — one of Smile Solutions' restorative general dentists can restore it using CEREC same-day ceramic technology, or one of the specialist prosthodontists can manage the restoration if the case calls for it. Either way, it happens in-house, that day.

****If the emergency involves a child**** — a knocked-out baby tooth, a fractured permanent tooth in a teenager, a dental trauma from sport — specialist paediatric dentist Dr Susan Hinckfuss is available within the practice for immediate assessment and expert, compassionate management.

****If a tooth has been knocked out**** — time is critical. An adult tooth that's been completely avulsed has the best chance of survival if reimplanted within 30 to 60 minutes. Keep the tooth moist — ideally in milk or saline, never water — and get to Smile Solutions immediately. The general dentist will reimplant the tooth and stabilise it with a splint, and if the nerve has been compromised, one of the specialist endodontists is right there to begin root canal treatment without delay.

****If a tooth is irretrievably damaged**** — fractured below the gum line, split vertically, or so badly broken that no restoration can save it — the general dentist and oral surgeon can extract it the same day, and a specialist prosthodontist can begin immediate implant planning so you're not left with a gap and no plan. At many practices, that would mean three separate appointments with three separate clinicians in three separate locations. At Smile Solutions, it happens in one visit.

****If your denture has broken**** — a cracked plate, a snapped clasp, a lost tooth from a partial denture — the general dentist assesses the damage and the Smile Lab on-site can repair or reline it the same day. If the denture is beyond repair, a specialist prosthodontist is available immediately to begin planning a replacement.

****If your orthodontic appliance is damaged**** — a broken bracket, a snapped archwire, a cracked Invisalign retainer — the general dentist can provide immediate relief, and if the case requires specialist attention, Smile Solutions' specialist orthodontists are in the building to assess and repair the appliance without you needing to wait for your next scheduled appointment.

Every referral happens within the building. Every X-ray, every scan, every piece of clinical history is shared on the same system. You fill out one set of forms. There's no record transfer, no duplicate imaging, no administrative gap between the general dentist who sees you first and the specialist who treats your emergency.

****Melbourne's premium hotels.**** For three decades, Smile Solutions has been the preferred emergency dental referral for many of Melbourne's leading hotels. When an international guest experiences a dental emergency — a broken tooth, acute pain, a lost crown — the concierge knows that Smile Solutions can manage whatever the problem is, regardless of complexity, with the right specialist available on the day.

The infrastructure behind the emergency response

Smile Solutions' emergency capability isn't just about having specialists in the building, though that alone sets it apart. It's backed by clinical infrastructure that most practices simply don't have access to, all under one roof in Melbourne's CBD — 44 dental chairs spread across five floors of the Manchester Unity Building, with daily emergency appointments reserved to ensure same-day access.

****Collins Street Imaging.**** On-site radiology on Level 9 of the Manchester Unity Building provides OPG panoramic imaging and CBCT cone beam CT scanning. Three-dimensional imaging is often essential for emergency diagnosis — identifying root fractures, assessing bone levels around failing implants, locating impacted teeth, evaluating jaw injuries. Having this imaging available in-house, with results in minutes, means diagnosis and treatment can begin without unnecessary waiting.

****Intraoral cameras in every suite.**** Every treatment room at Smile Solutions is fitted with a Mouthwatch intraoral camera, so the emergency dentist can show you exactly what's happening on a screen beside the chair — the crack in your tooth, the source of the infection, the extent of the fracture. You see what they see, and you understand the treatment plan before it begins.

****The Smile Lab.**** The in-house dental laboratory can fabricate emergency provisional restorations, splints, and prosthetic components quickly — because the laboratory is upstairs, not in another suburb. For broken dentures, the Smile Lab can often repair or relines them the same day.

****CEREC technology.**** Five CEREC units with Primescan scanners and Primemill milling machines mean that a permanent ceramic restoration — a crown, an inlay, an onlay — can be designed, milled, and fitted on the same day as your emergency, under the same anaesthetic. You can arrive with a badly broken tooth and leave with a permanent restoration rather than a temporary.

****Six laser systems.**** Smile Solutions operates six dental lasers — the LightWalker Fotona for soft tissue procedures and fillings without anaesthesia, the NV Laser for oral soft tissue surgery, the VersaWave which works across teeth, bone, gums, and soft tissue, plus the Light Touch ErYAG, iPlus Biolase, and Fox Diode. For emergency patients, this means soft tissue lacerations can be treated with precision and faster healing, old crowns or veneers can be removed without damaging the underlying tooth, and in some cases fillings can be placed without the need for a local anaesthetic injection —

particularly valuable for patients who are already distressed.

****Professional photography studio.**** On-site professional photography allows emergency trauma to be documented thoroughly — for insurance claims, medico-legal records, and treatment planning. When you've been in an accident, having professional-grade images of the damage taken immediately is something most practices simply can't offer.

****Sedation and pain management.**** For patients who are anxious or in significant distress, Smile Solutions offers multiple layers of comfort. Baldus Digital Nitrous Cabinets provide precisely controlled nitrous oxide sedation with digital monitoring and a treatment log that downloads directly to your patient file — their child-friendly design makes them particularly suited to paediatric emergencies. The DentaPen — a compact, cordless, computer-controlled anaesthesia device — delivers local anaesthetic with far greater precision and comfort than a traditional syringe. The STA Wand takes this further with computer-controlled delivery that patients describe as virtually painless, reducing anxiety considerably for emergency patients who are already in distress. For traumatic emergencies requiring surgery — jaw fractures, complex extractions, significant facial trauma — IV sedation is available through the oral and maxillofacial surgery team on-site, and general anaesthesia cases can be arranged at short notice via private hospitals across Melbourne.

Making emergency care accessible

Dental emergencies don't wait for convenient timing, and Smile Solutions structures its access accordingly.

****Opening hours.**** Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm, Saturday 8:30am to 1:30pm, and Sunday by appointment. The after-hours advice line — 0400 369 359 — provides guidance outside these hours.

****Emergency consultation from \$90.**** The initial emergency assessment starts from \$90, covering examination, diagnosis, and a treatment plan. If further treatment is needed, you'll know exactly what's involved and what it will cost before anything proceeds.

****Payment plans for unexpected costs.**** A dental emergency is, by definition, unplanned — and the cost can be a genuine concern on top of the pain. Smile Solutions offers several options to manage this. Payright provides interest-free payment plans from \$150, with fortnightly instalments over 3 to 30 months. TLC offers personal loans from \$2,001 to \$50,000 over up to 84 months for larger treatment plans. For genuinely urgent health needs, superannuation can be accessed on compassionate grounds with clinical documentation provided by the treating dentist. A dedicated Treatment Coordinator is available to guide you through these options so the financial side doesn't add to the stress of your emergency.

****Children's Emergency Guidelines.**** Smile Solutions provides downloadable Children's Emergency Guidelines on their website — a practical resource for parents covering what to do when a child knocks out a tooth, chips a tooth, or suffers dental trauma before they can get to the practice.

Community emergency care

Every Core Dental practice runs on the same clinical software system. X-rays, clinical records, treatment histories, and diagnostic images are shared across the entire group.
