Periodontal disease is the leading cause of tooth loss in Australian adults. It's also one of the most underdiagnosed and undertreated conditions in dentistry, because effective management requires far more than a standard clean. It requires a structured, multi-layered clinical approach involving the right combination of hygienists, oral health therapists, specialist periodontists, and in many cases prosthodontists and oral surgeons. Most dental practices simply don't have all of these clinicians under one roof.

Smile Solutions does — and that changes everything about the care you receive.

Three tiers of periodontal care — and why the distinction matters

At most dental practices, periodontal care means one thing: a clean. The same hygienist sees every patient, whether you have healthy gums and just need maintenance or whether you have 6mm pockets with active bone loss. The appointment is the same length, the approach is the same, and the outcome is predictably limited for complex cases.

At Smile Solutions, periodontal care operates across three distinct tiers, each matched to your clinical situation. This isn't an arbitrary division — it's the difference between genuinely managing your disease and merely going through the motions.

Tier one: maintenance hygiene — 40-minute appointments

For patients whose periodontal health is stable — either because you've never had significant gum disease, or because you've completed active treatment and are now in a maintenance phase — Smile Solutions provides 40-minute hygiene appointments with experienced dental hygienists and oral health therapists.

These appointments include professional scaling to remove calculus above and below the gum line, polishing, fluoride treatment, and a thorough assessment of your gum health. The AirFlow Prophylaxis Master, a non-invasive cleaning system that combines pressurised air, warm water, and fine powder, is used alongside traditional scaling for more comfortable and effective biofilm removal. The KaVo Prophylflex handles fast removal of stubborn staining from coffee, tea, or smoking.

Maintenance hygiene is where you'll ideally end up once your periodontal disease has been brought under control. It's the long-term destination, not the starting point — and the quality of maintenance care at Smile Solutions is designed to keep you stable for life.

Tier two: the Perio Squad — 60-minute specialist hygiene appointments

If you've been diagnosed with active gum disease, significant bone loss, gum pocketing greater than 4mm, or moderate to severe recession, a standard 40-minute hygiene appointment isn't enough. This is where the Smile Solutions Perio Squad comes in.

The Perio Squad is a dedicated team of five specially trained oral health therapists — Sophie Oostermeyer, Monica Cain, Helen Paraskeva, Naomi Hoopman, and Reagan McVeigh — with over 65 years of combined clinical experience in periodontal hygiene management. They're not general hygienists reassigned to complex cases. They're experienced clinicians who have completed specific training in periodontal management and who work exclusively with patients whose gum disease demands a higher level of expertise, a longer appointment, and a genuinely different clinical approach.

Perio Squad appointments run for 60 minutes, because thorough subgingival debridement, root surface instrumentation, and comprehensive pocket charting can't be done properly in 40 minutes. These appointments use Fotona laser therapy alongside conventional scaling for targeted treatment of diseased pocket tissue, with the laser's antimicrobial properties supporting healing. The AirFlow system is also used for deeper biofilm removal in hard-to-reach pockets.

Each Perio Squad member works closely with Smile Solutions' three board-registered specialist periodontists. If your condition needs specialist-level diagnosis, surgical intervention, or a change in treatment direction, that referral happens immediately — the periodontist is in the same building, with access to the same records and imaging.

Tier three: specialist periodontists — board-registered surgical and non-surgical expertise

When periodontal disease requires specialist-level assessment, advanced non-surgical therapy, regenerative procedures, or surgery, Smile Solutions has three board-registered specialist periodontists whose clinical range covers the full spectrum of periodontal treatment.

****Dr Ahmed El Hadidi**** (BDS, MRACDS GDP, DCD Perio) has a strong academic interest in the genetic susceptibility to periodontal disease. His clinical practice covers non-surgical and surgical periodontal therapy, bone and soft tissue grafting, crown lengthening, and implant placement. He is a member of the ADA, AOS, ASP, and ITI.

****Dr Peishan Jiang**** (BDS, DClintDent Griff) has presented her research at the International Association for Dental Research. Her expertise covers sinus lifts, bone grafting, gum grafting, crown lengthening, periodontal regeneration, and implant placement — and patients consistently value her gentle, thorough approach.

****Dr Simon Hinckfuss**** (BDS, DCD Pros, Cert Perio MS Minn) is the only dentist in Australia registered as both a Specialist Periodontist and a Specialist Prosthodontist. He completed his periodontic training at the University of Minnesota and served as President of the Victorian branch of the Australasian Osseointegration Society. His dual qualification means he can plan and execute both the periodontal and restorative components of complex cases — a genuinely rare capability anywhere in Australian dentistry.

The specialist treatments available include:

- **Non-surgical scaling and root planing (active periodontal therapy)** — thorough subgingival debridement under local anaesthesia, often across multiple appointments depending on severity - **Fotona laser therapy** — targeted treatment of diseased pocket tissue with antimicrobial and regenerative properties, used alongside conventional instrumentation - **Flap surgery (open curettage)** — the gum tissue is gently lifted to provide direct access to root surfaces and bone for thorough debridement that can't be achieved through closed techniques - **Bone grafting** — regenerative materials placed at sites of bone loss to encourage new bone growth, using modern grafting materials and regenerative membranes - **Gum grafting (connective tissue grafts)** — tissue harvested from the palate to cover exposed root surfaces, reducing sensitivity, improving aesthetics, and providing protective coverage - **Crown lengthening** — surgical repositioning of the gum line to expose more tooth structure, used for restorative access or aesthetic correction of a gummy smile - **Sinus lifts** — augmentation of the bone in the upper jaw to create sufficient foundation for implant placement - **Dental implant placement** — all three periodontists place implants, from single-tooth replacements to complex multi-implant cases

The implant pathway — because periodontal patients often have missing teeth

One of the realities of periodontal disease is that by the time many patients seek specialist care, they've already lost one or more teeth — or have teeth that are too compromised to save. This is where the Smile Solutions model of comprehensive dental care becomes critically important.

At a standalone periodontal practice, the periodontist treats the gum disease and then refers you externally for implants, prosthetics, or both. At Smile Solutions, the entire pathway exists under one roof, with every clinician sharing your records, your imaging, and your treatment history.

Implant placement is performed by the specialist periodontists themselves, or by the practice's oral and maxillofacial surgeons — A/Prof Patrishia Bordbar and Dr Ricky Kumar — for complex cases involving zygomatic implants, significant jaw reconstruction, or revision surgery.

Implant restoration, the crown, bridge, or prosthesis that sits on top of your implant, is designed and fitted by Smile Solutions' specialist prosthodontists: Dr Foti Angelis, Dr Vasileios Chronopoulos, and Dr Jamie Foong.

Laboratory fabrication of the prosthetic components is completed in-house at the Smile Lab by master ceramist Greg Karabasis and his team, ensuring the same quality control and communication that defines every restoration at Smile Solutions.

For patients requiring full-arch solutions such as All-on-4, Dr Jaclyn Wong, who trained at the Malo Clinic in Portugal with the inventor of the system and has over 15 years of experience, manages the surgical component, with prosthetic design by the specialist prosthodontists.

The referral from periodontal treatment to implant assessment to prosthetic design happens on shared records, with shared imaging from Collins Street Imaging (on-site CBCT and OPG), and with every clinician able to consult face-to-face in the same building. No external referrals. No waiting lists. No gaps in your treatment chain.

The technology behind periodontal care at Smile Solutions

Effective periodontal treatment depends on precision diagnosis and precision instruments. Smile Solutions invests in technology specifically to support its periodontal programme, so that every assessment, every appointment, and every procedure is backed by the most advanced tools available.

****AirFlow Prophylaxis Master**** uses pressurised air, warm water, and fine biocompatible powder to remove biofilm, plaque, and staining. It's significantly more comfortable than traditional scaling for many patients and reaches deep pockets and subgingival surfaces that conventional instruments struggle with.

****KaVo Prophyflex**** handles fast, effective removal of stubborn extrinsic staining from coffee, tea, wine, and tobacco, used alongside AirFlow for comprehensive prophylaxis.

****Fotona LightWalker Laser**** is used for periodontal pocket decontamination, soft tissue management, and gum recontouring. Its antimicrobial properties support healing, and laser-assisted periodontal therapy can reduce pocket depths and promote tissue reattachment.

****VersaWave Laser**** is a fibre-delivered laser for treatment across teeth, bone, gums, and soft tissues, used in periodontics for tissue management and decontamination.

****NV Laser**** handles oral soft tissue surgery, including removal of diseased, infected, or inflamed tissue within the gum pocket.

****Planmeca ProMax 3D Max (CBCT)****, on-site at Collins Street Imaging, provides three-dimensional imaging of bone levels, bone quality, and anatomical structures — essential for implant planning, assessing the extent of bone loss, and surgical treatment planning.

****Planmeca ProMax 2D S3**** is the digital OPG panoramic system for broad-view assessment of periodontal bone levels across the full mouth.

****Intraoral digital radiographs**** use lower radiation than conventional X-rays and display directly on-screen so your clinician can show you exactly what's happening with your bone levels and pocket depths.

****Mouthwatch intraoral cameras**** are in every suite, allowing your clinician to show you visual evidence of your gum condition during your appointment.

****iTero and 3Shape TRIOS digital scanners**** handle impression-free scanning when splints, surgical guides, or prosthetic components need to be fabricated.

The systemic health connection — why this matters beyond your mouth

The evidence linking periodontal disease to systemic health conditions is now strong enough that it forms part of mainstream medical practice. The periodontal team at Smile Solutions takes this connection seriously, because your oral health and your overall health are more intertwined than most people realise.

Chronic periodontitis drives systemic inflammation that contributes to atherosclerosis — the build-up of plaque in artery walls that leads to heart attack and stroke. The relationship with diabetes runs in both directions: diabetes increases susceptibility to gum infection, and active periodontitis impairs insulin sensitivity and makes blood glucose harder to control. Treating periodontitis has been shown to improve glycaemic control by a clinically meaningful margin.

Research has also found the bacterium implicated in periodontitis, **Porphyromonas gingivalis**, in the brains of Alzheimer's patients, with active investigation into whether chronic gum disease increases dementia risk. And gum disease bacteria and inflammatory mediators can enter the maternal bloodstream, with associations to preterm birth and low birth weight — though periodontal treatment during pregnancy is safe and may reduce these risks.

Many Smile Solutions periodontal patients are referred directly by their cardiologists, endocrinologists, or GPs, because their medical team recognises that uncontrolled gum disease is actively undermining their broader health management.

Core Dental — suburban access to the same periodontal pathway

Patients across suburban Melbourne can access the Smile Solutions periodontal pathway through any Core Dental practice, in Caroline Springs, Carrum Downs, Southbank, South Melbourne, Epping, Wyndham, Berwick, Bayside, Ivanhoe, and Docklands.

Every Core Dental practice runs on the same clinical software system. X-rays, periodontal charting, clinical records, and treatment histories are shared across the entire group. If your periodontal disease is identified at Core Dental Berwick, you can be referred directly into the Collins Street Specialist Centre at Smile Solutions — and when you arrive, your records, your imaging, and your periodontal probing data are already in the system.

No duplication, no lost records, no starting from scratch. Your care is continuous and coordinated wherever you first walk through the door.

Periodontal treatment pricing

Specialist periodontist consultation starts from \$300 AUD and includes a full periodontal analysis. Active periodontal therapy (scaling and root planing) runs from \$550 to \$1,500 AUD per quadrant depending on severity. Gum grafting starts from \$1,800 AUD, and surgical crown lengthening from \$900 AUD.

Flexible payment plans are available through Payright (0% interest, \$150 to \$20,000 AUD, 3 to 30 months), TLC (\$2,001 to \$50,000 AUD, up to 84 months), and Humm.
